Chien-Chung Lin received the Ph.D. degree in EE from Stanford University, Stanford, CA, USA. He joined National Taiwan University in August, 2021 as a professor of Graduate Institute of Photonics and Optoelectronics. From 2009 to 2021, he was with National Chiao Tung University (NCTU). His research focuses on the design and fabrication of novel semiconductor optoelectronic devices, including LEDs, solar cells, and lasers. Since 2016, he has been jointly appointed by the Industrial Technology Research Institute (ITRI), where he participates and leads several projects in the micro LEDs, 3DIC, and silicon photonics. Before NCTU, he worked for start-ups, including E2O communications and Santur, in USA. From 2015 to 2017, he was the recipient of the Young Investigator Research Grant by Ministry of Science and Technology of Taiwan. He served as the chairperson of the Taipei chapter of the IEEE Photonics Society (2019-2020) and the Optoelectronic Devices Committee member of the IEEE Electron Device Society (2020-2021). Currently he serves as the Associate Editor for IEEE Transactions on Electron Devices (TED) and IEEE Journal of Quantum Electronics (JQE). He has more than 300 journal and conference publications and is a Fellow of the OPTICA (formerly OSA) and a senior member of the IEEE.
